

PROPOSED ICDBG APPLICATION

Due to the extreme shortage of affordable housing in the greater Santa Rosa area, and because many Tribal Members live in this area, Kashia Housing Department is proposing to submit an application for a ICDBG (Indian Community Development Block Grant) Grant which is due on June 14, 2016.

This is a competitive federal grant, and if awarded, the award could be up to \$605,000. The funding can only be used for affordable housing activities. Kashia Housing Department proposes to use these funds (if awarded) towards the purchase land in the Santa Rosa area on which to build affordable rental housing for low-income Tribal families.

This is a multi-year project and the first step is to acquire land. But we need to hear from you!

Kashia Housing will be holding a meeting on Thursday, May 19th, 2016 at the Housing office at 1420 Guerneville Road, Suite 3 (to the left of the Tribal Office), from 6pm to 7pm. The meeting will provide attendees with info about the ICDBG Grant, the potential funds, and the range of possible activities that the funds can be used for. This is an informational meeting and a chance to comment and discuss these ideas. Please RSVP as we will be serving refreshments.
