- You can't have worked more than 16 weeks out of the last 26 weeks (6 months)
- Able to do **HARD** physical labor

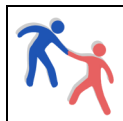

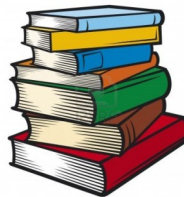
