The new Kashia Housing
Authority is looking for interested Kashia Tribal Members
to sit on the inaugural Board
of Commissioners
(BOC). Qualifications of
Commissioners: Each person
appointed to the Board of
Commissioners must satisfy
all requirements. (Please contact the Tribal Office for a full
list of requirements.)

(1) Each Commissioner must be a duly enrolled member of the Tribe (2) Each Commissioner must be at least 21 years of age

(3) Each Commissioner must possess a high school diploma, GED or comparable educational certificate

(4) No person may serve as a Commissioner while holding any position on the Tribal Council

Tribal Council (5) No person that has been convicted of or pled guilty or no contest to any felony charge involving violence (such as murder, rape, or child or elder abuse), financial crime (such as embezzlement) or dishonesty (such as fraud) may serve as a Commissioner

as a Commissioner
(6) No person that has been convicted of
a felony other than as defined in paragraph (5) above within five (5) years
prior to the date of his or her appointment may serve as a Commissioner. 5
(7) No person may serve as a Commissioner if he or she has more than (1)
Immediate Family Member serving on
the Board

(8) No person may serve as a Commissioner if he or she, or an Immediate Family Member, has a financial interest in any vendor providing goods or services under contract to the Authority in connection with a Housing Project or otherwise, or any similar conflict of

interest.

(9) Each Commissioner must be available to perform all the duties required by this Ordinance, the Board's By-Laws and applicable policies and procedures.

Please have your letter of interest, resume and application back to the Housing Department by **January 17**, **2020.** The 7 member BOC is an appointment of the Kashia Tribal Council. The BOC will select from themselves the officers of the BOC.
